

Voorwoord

“Die kinderliedjies van Rykie Pienaar, hoewel dit kom uit ’n tydperk wat nou reeds as “uit vergange se dae” beskryf sou kon word, besit ’n ingeboude tydloosheid. Hierdie eienskap is die geheim van die sukses daarvan en kan hoofsaaklik aan twee faktore toegeskryf word: singbaarheid vir die kinderstem en volkome inbedding in die leefwêreld van die jonger kind. Rykie Pienaar het die dinge verstaan en musiekopvoedingsmateriaal daargestel wat tydloos en bruikbaar is.

Die klavierbegeleidings van die liedere is van so ’n aard dat die musiekonderwyser, met selfs ’n karige klavierspelvaardigheid, die begeleidings sal kan baasraak. Dit is verder moontlik om die eenvoudige, harmoniese ondersteuning in ’n nabygeleë toonsoort te speel, indien die omstandighede dit vereis.” Niel van der Watt

Hierdie kinderliedjies is volledig ingestudeer deur die Tygerberg Kinderkoor onder leiding van Hennie Loock. Dit is opgeneem op twee Cd’s. Die vervaardiging van die twee Cd’s het tegnies kontrasterend plaasgevind:

Cd een kan beskou word as “lewendig” of “realisties-eksperimenteel”. Alle komponente (sang, klavier en orkesinstrumente) is tydens ’n enkele geleentheid in ’n konsertsaal opgeneem. Skrapse tot geen elektroniese redigering het plaasgevind.

Cd twee kan beskou word as “eietyds”. Sang en klavier is in ’n konsertsaal opgeneem en daarna elektronies geredigeer in ’n ateljee. Instrumentaliste is agterna individueel gekontrakteur om opnames in die ateljee saam met die sang- en klavier- snit te gaan doen. Na afloop daarvan het verskeie elektroniese redigerings tot die eindproduk gelei.

Die Cd-begeleidings is verwerkings deur Niel van der Watt en sluit bykans alle orkesinstrumente in.

Klavierbegeleiding deur Anneke Lamont (Cd 1) en Tertia Visser Downie (Cd2) gedoen.
